"Each school district, now or hereafter established, when validly organized and existing, is declared to be a body corporate and politic, and in its corporate capacity may sue and be sued and may acquire, hold and convey real and personal property necessary to its establishment, extension and existence. It shall leave the authority to issue negotiable coupon bonds and incur such other debts, in the amounts and manner, as provided by law."

FILER SCHOOL DISTRICT #413

BEGINNING at a point in the middle of the main channel of the Snake River at approximately the center of Sec. 10, Twp. 9 S, R 15 EBM; thence following the main channel of the Snake River in a southeasterly direction to the mouth of Rock Creek; thence southerly following Rock Creek to its intersection with the south section line of Sec. 36, Twp. 9 S, R 16 EBM; thence west on the township line to the southeast corner of Sec. 34, said township and range; thence on the section line south 7 miles to the southeast corner of Sec. 3, Twp. 11 S, R 16 EBM; thence east ½ mile to the north ¼ corner of Sec. 11, said township and range; thence south ¼ mile to the SE corner of the NE ¼, NW ¼ of Sec. 11; thence east 2 miles to the SE corner of the NE ¼, NW ¼ of Sec. 7, Twp. 11 S, R 17 EBM; thence south ¼ mile; thence east 1 mile to the center of Sec. 8; thence south 1 ½ miles to the south ¼ corner of Sec. 17, Twp. 11 S, R 17 EBM; thence west 1 mile; thence south 1 mile; thence west ½ mile to the SW corner of Sec. 19; thence on the section line south 3 miles to the SW corner of Sec. 6, Twp. 12 S, R 17 EBM; thence east 4 ½ miles, more or less, to the north ¼ corner of Sec. 11; thence south on the north-south centerline 5 miles to the south ¼ corner of Sec. 35, Twp. 12 S, R 17 EBM; thence east 1 ½ miles, more or less, to the NE corner of Sec. 1, Twp. 13 S, R 17 EBM; thence on the range line south 6 miles to the SE corner of Sec. 36; thence on the township line east 6 miles to the Cassia County line; thence following the Twin Falls-Cassia County line south 17 miles, more or less, to the Nevada State line; thence following the Idaho-Nevada State line west 22 ¾ miles, more or less, to its intersection with Salmon Falls Creek; thence following the channel of Salmon Falls Creek in a northerly direction to its intersection with the line common to Sec. 36, Twp. 12 S, R 14 EBM, and Sec. 31, Twp. 12 S, R 15 EBM; thence on the range line north 10 ¼ miles, more or less, to its intersection with the High Line Canal; thence following the High Line Canal in a northeasterly direction to its intersection with the west boundary line of Sec. 32, Twp. 10 S, R 15 EBM; thence north to the west ¼ corner of said Sec. 32; thence east to the center of said Sec. 32; thence south to the High Line Canal; thence easterly and northerly following the High Line Canal to its intersection with the east-west centerline of said Sec. 32; thence east on the east-west centerline of Sec. 32 & 33, Twp. 10 S, R 15 EBM, to the center of said Sec. 33; thence north ½ mile to the north ¼ corner of said Sec 33; thence west to the High Line Canal; thence northeasterly following the High Line Canal to its intersection with the west section line of Sec. 27, Twp. 10 S, R 15 EBM; thence north on the section line 4 ½ miles, more or less, to the SW corner of Sec. 34, Twp. 9 S, R 15 EBM; thence east 1 ½ miles, more or less, to the south ¼ corner of Sec. 35; thence north on the mid-section line 4 ¼ miles, more or less, to the NE corner of the SE ¼, SW ¼, Sec. 11, Twp. 9 S, R 15 EBM; thence west approximately ½ mile to the south rim of the Snake River Canyon; thence westerly along said south rim to its intersection with the north-south centerline of Sec. 10, Twp. 9 S, R 15 EBM; thence north on the north-south centerline of said Sec. 10 to its intersection with the middle of the channel of the Snake River, the point of beginning.

This District is designated as Filer School District No. 413, Twin Falls County, State of Idaho. The District conducts an educational program adopted by the Board of Trustees according to a calendar which meets the required days of school as specified by the Idaho State Department of Education.

We believe that School District No. 413 should be organized around a pattern that will give all students an opportunity to maximize their potential. We further recognize that no educational organization should be so solidified that new organizational patterns are difficult to implement as educational research gives greater insights into how children learn.

The school system shall consist of the following organizational units as the standard types of programs to offer instruction:

- A. Elementary School (K-5 or K-3 6)
- B. Intermediate School (4-6)
- C. Middle School (6 7-8)
- D. Senior High (9-12)
- E. Special Education (Ages 3 to 21)

The Filer School District shall be divided into two elementary attendance areas. The Hollister Elementary attendance area shall consist of that portion of the Filer School District that lies south of the N3400 road (commonly known as the Les Jones Road or Airport Road). The Filer Elementary attendance areas shall consist of that portion of the Filer School District that lies north of the N3400 road. The Filer secondary attendance areas shall consist of the entire Filer School District.
