The Board of Trustees, when advertising for bids on contracts for the construction, repair or improvement of buildings, shall make written plans and specifications for such work to be performed of materials furnished.

Such plans and specifications shall be available for all interested and perspective bidders. Bidders may be required to make a reasonable deposit upon obtaining a copy of such plans and specifications.

All plans and specifications for contracts or materials shall state, among other things pertinent to the work to be performed of materials furnished, the number, size, kind and quality of materials and service required for such contract. Such plans and specifications shall not specify or provide the use of any articles of a specific brand or mark, or any patented apparatus or appliances when other materials are available for such purpose and when such requirements would prevent competitive bidding on the part of dealers or contractors in other articles or materials of equivalent value, utility or merit.

Because rented facilities, relocatable units, and other emergency school-housing are almost invariably inadequate for public school purposes, it is the aim of the Board to have sufficient permanent facilities to meet the needs of school enrollment and the school program.

If circumstances require immediate space which is not available in public school buildings, facilities will be rented and relocatable structures used, only as a temporary, emergency measure. Any such facility must conform to all appropriate state and local building and land use codes, health and fire laws, and environmental standards.
