

MINUTES OF A SPECIAL EMERGENCY MEETING OF
BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF FILER
SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 413,
TWIN FALLS COUNTY, STATE OF IDAHO
MAY 31, 2022

A special emergency meeting of the Board of Trustees of School District No. 413, Twin Falls County, State of Idaho was convened at 4:00 p.m. on May 31, 2022 at the Filer School District Conference Room in said district, pursuant to authority provided by Section 33-510 and 67-2340 through 67-2347, Idaho Code, and pursuant to affirmation by the Clerk that notice of the special meeting had been given to each trustee and had been announced by written public notice posted at the school district office and at least two or more public buildings within the school district not less than twenty-four hours before such meeting was to be convened. The Affidavit of Posting of Notice and a copy of the notice of a special meeting of School Trustees were entered into the record and are attached hereto.

Present at the meeting were Chairman Julie Koyle, Trustees Jenni Lanting, Bob Burnham, Ryan Gurney, Superintendent Kelli Schroeder, and Clerk Teresa Kullhem when the meeting was called to order at 4:02 p.m. by Chairman Koyle.

Trustee Gurney made a motion to approve the agenda. Trustee Lanting seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Ratification of Collective Bargaining Agreement for 2022-2023
