

MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING OF
BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF FILER
SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 413,
TWIN FALLS COUNTY, STATE OF IDAHO
MAY 9, 2023

A special meeting of the Board of Trustees of School District No. 413, Twin Falls County, State of Idaho was convened at 5:15 p.m. on May 9, 2023 at the Filer Intermediate School Library in said district, pursuant to authority provided by Section 33-510 and 67-2340 through 67-2347, Idaho Code, and pursuant to affirmation by the Clerk that notice of the special meeting had been given to each trustee and had been announced by written public notice posted at the school district office and at least two or more public buildings within the school district not less than twenty-four hours before such meeting was to be convened. The Affidavit of Posting of Notice and a copy of the notice of a special meeting of School Trustees were entered into the record and are attached hereto.

Present at the meeting were Chairman Julie Koyle, Trustees Bob Burnham, Joe Maloney, Bill Deetz, Superintendent Kelli Schroeder, Business Manager Arron Phinney, and Clerk Teresa Kullhem when the meeting was called to order at 5:22 p.m. by Chairman Koyle.

Trustee Lanting entered the meeting at 5:25 p.m.

In accordance with Idaho code 33-1809 regarding Accountability and Continuous Improvement, Cara Joslin, district Instructional Coach, will be presenting the required literacy training for the board of trustees.

Within the instruction model, there are three tiers. Most students should fall into Tier 1, proficient. 15-25% of students should fall into tier 2, and those who need the most help would fall into Tier 3. Filer School District teachers receive literacy training to learn strategies for interventions. IRI tests are state mandated tests that are taken in the fall and in the spring. Filer School District students take them every month so they are familiar with testing and so principals can monitor progress more closely.

Goal setting is another important piece to improving student literacy. There are school-wide goals, teacher goals, and student goals.

Chairman Koyle adjourned the meeting at 5:50 p.m.
