

MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING OF
BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF FILER
SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 413,
TWIN FALLS COUNTY, STATE OF IDAHO
AUGUST 12, 2024

A special meeting of the Board of Trustees of School District No. 413, Twin Falls County, State of Idaho was convened at 7:00 a.m. on August 12, 2024 at the Filer School District Conference Room, 301 Highway 30, Filer, ID, in said district, pursuant to authority provided by Section 33-510 and 67-2340 through 67-2347, Idaho Code, and pursuant to affirmation by the Clerk that notice of the special meeting had been given to each trustee and had been announced by written public notice posted at the school district office and at least two or more public buildings within the school district not less than twenty-four hours before such meeting was to be convened.

Present at the meeting were Chairman Jenni Lanting, Trustees Jeff Volle, Tammy Kelly, Joe Maloney and Bill Deetz, Superintendent Kelli Schroeder, and Clerk Teresa Kullhem when the meeting was called to order at 7:03 a.m. by Chairman Lanting.

Trustee Volle made a motion to approve the agenda. Trustee Kelly seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Financing of New Bus

The board needs to approve the purchase of a new bus to primarily be used for extracurricular activities with the undercarriage storage and air conditioning.

Trustee Kelly approved the purchase of a new bus at \$206,000 to be financed through D.L. Evans Bank. Trustee Maloney seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

District Branding

The Filer High School Administrative team is present today to get clear direction from the board regarding the use of the district copyrighted logo package and wildcat mascot head. New Athletic Director, Brodie Parrott, gave the board his vision and direction as he begins to work in the program.

Superintendent Schroeder spoke to the need for consistency in all schools with the logo, mascot, and colors.

The board would like any sports team to use the district copyright wildcat head and the lettering used can be up to the individual sport. The board, in general, expressed the need to gain a consistent use of the district's copyrighted wildcat head with anything required by any sport in the district.

Trustee Maloney made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Trustee Volle seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.
